Sports Excellence Programs to identify and nurture sports talent from 'grassroot to elite'



Using PathwayZ by Sportz Village, Sportz Village Foundation aims at laying a roadmap for student-athletes from Government schools by providing quality sport-specific training and resources to become champions of tomorrow. #SportForChange by Sportz Village Foundation uses physical education and sports to generate positive health, educational and developmental outcomes in school children. PathwayZ will further enable talented student-athletes from underserved communities get access to opportunities to excel in sports, thus building a sports talent pool for the country.

Objective of #SportForChange PathwayZ

Identify and develop grassroot sporting talent in children (13 to 19 years) from Govt. schools and target communities into elite athletes by providing quality sports training, match/tournament exposure and access to national and international grassroot scouting trials like IKF, Jr NBA etc
